

DON'S STORY "Growing up was hard. I was born to teenage parents

that were addicted to drugs and alcohol. My dad went to prison early on in my life which left my family very poor. There were many instances when we didn't have food to eat. I remember sleeping on bed crates. The pain I went through as a child is something God is still helping me deal with to this day. When I was 7 years old a nightclub owner and friend of my mom noticed our situation and invited my sister and I to church, and we agreed to go. All of a sudden on Sundays I had normalcy, people that loved me and people who told me God loved me. It changed everything. I felt like if I got to know this God, that he was going to make everything ok for me. And, at 8 years old, I gave my heart to God and in God's timing, years later my mom hit rock bottom and found herself in need of grace. Through a series of events my mom got plugged into a rehabilitation ministry in the church I was attending. At 12 years old, my mom gave her heart to God. Now my family was attending church together, my mom started leading a women's addiction over-comers ministry, our financial situation improved, my mom got her GED and bachelor's degree. I watched God take us from sorrow and darkness into light. If it wasn't for the church, I would be in a much different situation today as an adult. An invitation to church not only changed my life but my family's life as well. "

HAILEY'S STORY

"At around 8 years old I went into the foster care system. The family I stayed with were Christians, and I was not. But, I learned about prayer with them and would pray every night to be able to go back with my birth family. As time passed, my situation didn't change, and I felt like God wasn't listening. I eventually found out that I was going to be adopted with my three younger siblings, and stay permanently in the home we were placed in. I had to give up my plan to be with my birth family all together, so I found things that made me feel linked to them like music and singing. I would constantly either be listening to music or I would be singing. As part of attending church with my new family, I attended Youth Camp with Summit Park Youth. At camp I realized I couldn't stop singing worship. The lyrics were stuck in my head and God used worship and music to make me feel connected to where I came from and reach me right where I was at. I prayed with my small group leader and gave my heart to God. God didn't just see me, but He knew me and knew how to help me. Nothing is just coincidence. All things happen for a reason and even though my story is different than I expected, it's all a part of His plan and that plan is good."


